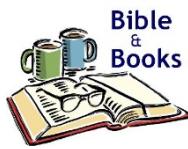
- If you know of someone who will be graduating this year, please submit their name and what grade they are graduating from to the office or the clergy team. If they are receiving a degree, what kind and from where.

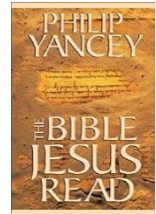

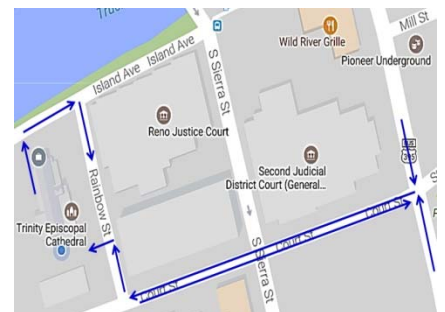
