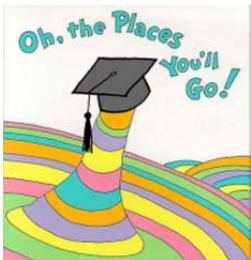

SANDBAGS FOR FREE! Over the next two weeks, parishioners are invited to stop by and take as many sandbags as they wish from our northwest corner, now that we've ridden out the major flooding danger. The bags themselves are biodegradable and can be put into regular recycling. The sand can be used in many ways: For fill in xeriscaping to save water, as a fill between paving stones, as an environmentally kind way to cover icy roads and sidewalks in the winter, and it can be mixed into concrete or mortar as a base for sidewalks or pavement. Help yourself! After the two weeks, we will be looking for volunteers to remove the remaining sandbags to a designated drop off site in Reno.
