**WE WELCOME YOU**, are glad you chose to be with us today, and are honored by your presence! We are here to welcome and serve all of God's people, so if we can be of service to you please let us know. We invite you to come to our Welcome Table at the back of the church, sign our Guest Book, and receive a gift. There is a welcome form in the pew if you would be willing to express your concerns or give us contact information. This form may be placed into the offering plate (this is all we expect of you at the Offertory, since you are our guest!) or given to one of the clergy when you depart.



**During Lent** we host a **Morning Prayer Service** at 7:30 AM every Monday through Thursday, and on Friday at 7:30 AM the **Stations of the Cross**.



**At 5:00 PM Wednesday Nights during Lent** we offer a prayer service in the manner of **Taizé**. This short, contemplative service features simple music in the form of chant, silence, and unembellished prayer. Service time runs about 30 minutes and it is led by Rev. Mikayla Dunfee.

### **A Spiritual Journey Wednesday evenings in Lent, 6:00 PM, Mar. 4–Apr. 1 Facilitated by Rev. Rick**

This study is to assist us to deepen our walk with Christ. Participants are invited to view their lives as a spiritual journey. We do not travel alone, however. We are joined by companions along the way. As together we begin this journey, we are also assured that Christ is in our midst. How do we encounter God, made known to us through Jesus Christ, in our day-to-day lives? How can we increase our awareness of God's presence among us? Those are the primary questions we will attempt to address along the way. There is no cost for this class.



**What is the Box in front of the Altar?** The Sunday before Ash Wednesday, the children of our 9:00 AM Children and Family Service processed an "Alleluia Banner" and sang for the last time a hymn with "Alleluias." During Lent we remove (put aside or "bury") the Alleluias from our liturgy (the word is not used at all during our worship) and return it to use at the Easter Vigil and Easter Day.

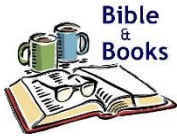


### **Fortune Cookie Lent!**

Through the month of March, Rev. Rick will be facilitating a class called Fortune Cookie Lent! Every week, participants will choose a Lenten Fortune which will give them their Lenten discipline for the week. For example, you might get a fortune that says, "Give to the poor." In

the coming week you might collect food for donation, or send a check to the Food Bank, or offer to help serve meals at St. Vincent's Diner, or go through your old clothes for donation. The following Sunday, we will gather and share what we did with our fortune for the week, and then pick a new fortune cookie! The Adult Forum meets in the Bishop Lewis Chapel every Sunday during the school year at 9:45 AM following the 9:00 AM liturgy. Stay after for it if you attend the 9:00 AM service; come early for the forum if you attend the 11:00 AM service!
