Maundy Thursday, April 18

- **11:00 AM - Chrism Mass with Renewal of Ordination Vows** – Bishop Jim Waggoner, preaching (*members are encouraged to attend in support of the area visiting clergy and spouses*)
- **Noon-Day Eucharist** (cancelled – please attend the Chrism Mass)
- **7:00 PM - Eucharist with Foot Washing.** The Service ends with the Stripping of the Altar in preparation for Good Friday. **All night Prayer Vigil** till sunrise Good Friday.

- **11:00 AM – Brief Service of Penance** with opportunity for **Private Confessions** with any of the attending priests

For those who have sponsored or paid for flowers, they will all be attributed to the Easter flowers and will be listed in the Easter bulletins. Maundy Thursday All Night Prayer Vigil. April 18th evening through April 19th Sunrise

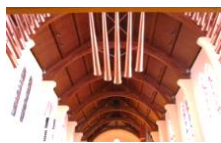
The ministry of the Maundy Thursday Prayer Vigil is a ‘once a year’ opportunity to spend time praying with our Lord as he commanded in that garden after the Lord Supper. He “commanded” that we stay awake and pray with him. The discipline of staying awake, praying and meditating is a ritual that has been practice for hundreds of years in the Episcopal Church (as well as by other Christians worldwide). It brings into focus the discipline of silent prayer in a corporate setting as others come forth throughout the night to spend time in individual prayer. We continue this tradition as our ancestors did. The spiritual impact of participating in this ritual is far reaching. Please consider joining us on this most holy night. In the middle of the night, Trinity is truly a ‘thin’ place.
