The use of the rosary as a focus for contemplative prayer and meditation experienced a revival in the Episcopal Church in the 1980's. A specific Anglican Rosary was developed during this period. By design, it both reflects our emphasis on incarnational theology and is more flexible for personalized prayers. If you already have an Anglican rosary, we will provide you with free instructions on how to pray with it. We also have inexpensive rosaries available for \$8.00 — you can get much nicer, more expensive ones on Amazon and other sites, but if you just want to explore, this is an inexpensive way to get started. Weekly Bible Study

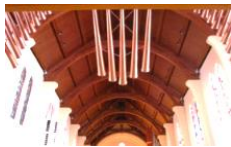
