## **Death Announcement of The Reverend John W. Steinfeld** **April 16, 1933 – June 30, 2018**

It is with very heavy hearts we announce the death of Father John Steinfeld. John has served here faithfully as a priest for many years and was fondly known for his Bible study. This past year we celebrated his 50th anniversary of ordination and his 85th birthday.

John's death involved a car accident on I-80 West on Saturday night, June 30 near midnight. We have been in touch with both his sons, Chris (California) and Scott (Idaho). We will plan a celebration of John's life and ministry here at the Cathedral in the very near future after Father William and Bishop Dan return from the General Church Convention in Austin, Texas. We will pass on that information as soon as we are able. Please keep John's sons and our church family in your prayers in light of this profound loss. We also ask your prayers for the three young people who also died in this accident, for their family and friends, and for those who survived and are recovering.

## **Update from the Dean at our National Convention in Austin Texas**



The triennial General Convention of the Episcopal Church is meeting in Austin, Texas July 5–13. Our Dean, Fr. William Stomski, called in to let us know the opening Eucharist at the Convention was amazing! The Episcopal News Service reports "the opening Eucharist of the 79th General Convention of the Episcopal Church on July 5 included lively music in many styles, communion for thousands of people and a sermon by Presiding Bishop Michael Curry calling on members of the Episcopal Church to embrace spiritual practices that can help lead them to a Jesus-centered life." Fr. William was impressed how they took a convention hall, but through the use of projections of stained glass, made it feel like they were celebrating the Eucharist in a church.
