We will supply condiments for the hot dogs and burgers

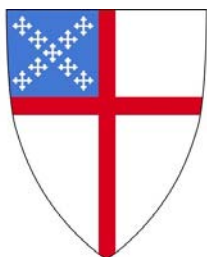

Here is an opportunity to explore the Celtic roots of our Anglican/Episcopal Church by visiting many of the historical sites of early Christianity in England and Scotland. Led by the Dean of our Cathedral, Father William Stomski, this 11 day trip includes such places as Canterbury Cathedral, the Holy Island of Lindisfarne and the Island of Iona, and York Minster.
